Parent Contract 2026

Summary

This agreement outlines the responsibilities of both the International British Theatre School (IBTS) and parents/carers to ensure the safety, wellbeing, and positive experience of all children attending IBTS programmes.

It complies with the requirements of the EYFS 2024, KCSIE 2025, and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Attendance and Care

- I consent for my child to attend International British Theatre School (IBTS) and agree to abide by all relevant policies and procedures.
- I understand that once my child is signed in, they are in the legal care of IBTS until collected and signed out by an authorised adult.
- I will inform the camp manager before the session begins if my child will not be attending, or if I will be collecting them directly from school.
- I understand that booked sessions remain chargeable unless cancellation terms have been agreed with the manager.

Health and Safety

- I will inform IBTS immediately of any changes to my child's health, medication, contact details, or dietary needs.
- If my child has a contagious illness, I will follow exclusion guidance from UK Health Security Agency (formerly Public Health England) or the relevant local authority.
- I understand that my child may take part in creative or messy activities. I may provide suitable clothing for this purpose.

• I acknowledge that while every effort is made to keep belongings safe, IBTS cannot accept responsibility for lost or damaged property.

Timings and Late Collection

- IBTS operates until 4:00pm unless otherwise stated.
- If I expect to be late, I will contact the manager or deputy as soon as possible.
- If my child is not collected by 4:15pm, I agree to pay a late collection charge of £17.50 per 15 minutes to cover staffing costs.
- If my child has not been collected by 4:30pm, and staff cannot reach any authorised contacts, IBTS will follow the Uncollected Children Policy and contact Social Care in line with safeguarding procedures.

Behaviour and Conduct

- I have read and understood the Behaviour and Conduct Management Policy 2026 and agree to support its principles.
- I understand that IBTS reserves the right to suspend or exclude a child in serious or repeated cases of unacceptable behaviour, and that fees will still apply for missed sessions unless agreed otherwise.
- I understand that aggressive or abusive behaviour towards staff will not be tolerated and may result in termination of this agreement.

Accidents, Incidents, and Medical Treatment

• If my child is involved in an accident or incident, I will be informed as soon as possible.

- Minor injuries will be treated by a qualified first aider.
- If urgent medical treatment is required and I am unavailable, a member of IBTS staff may sign consent for emergency treatment in accordance with my child's **Medical** Consent Form.

Confidentiality and Safeguarding

- IBTS treats all information as confidential and processes data in line with the Data Protection Act 2018 and UK GDPR.
- However, I understand that if there are safeguarding concerns, IBTS has a legal duty to share relevant information with agencies such as Social Care, the Police, or health professionals under Working Together to Safeguard Children (2023).
