Roadmap to the Stage

Every day of the week builds purposefully towards Friday's Grand Showcase. Here is your child's journey from first ensemble to final bow.

1 Monday – Ensemble, Casting & Musicality

Icebreakers, choral work, and group movement. Students are cast for the Friday performance and learn the opening song and dance together.

2 Tuesday – The Actor's Voice

Dedicated focus on projection, British RP accents, and character-building techniques that bring roles vividly to life.

3 Wednesday – Physical Theatre

Mime, slapstick comedy, and safe stage combat choreography — exploring the full expressive power of the body on stage.

4 Thursday – The Technical Transition

Dress Runs 1 & 2 plus a full Tech Run. Students learn backstage etiquette, stage geography, and how to work with professional lighting and sound cues.

5 Friday – The Grand Showcase

Morning: two full dress rehearsals where groups perform for each other. At 15:00: the Final Performance for parents, followed by a celebratory Short Award Ceremony honouring every student's achievements.

Technical Theatre

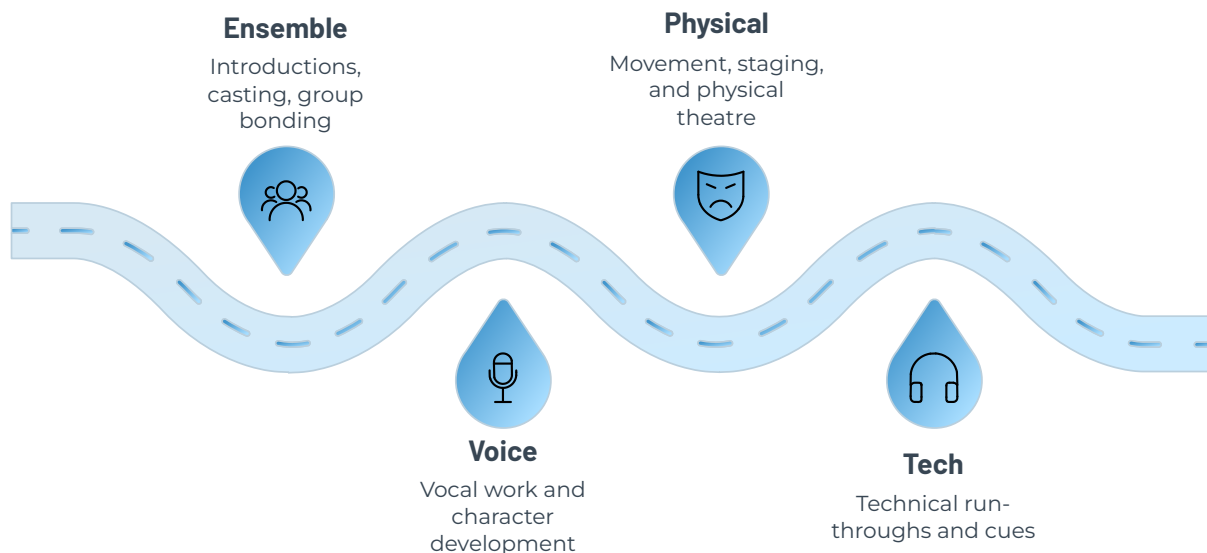
Lighting cues, sound operation, and professional backstage etiquette.
